#### Notes

Private Native Forestry Plans (PNF Plans) do not authorise the carrying out of forestry operations on any part of the land that is an area of the State to which Part 5B of the *Local Land Services Act 2013* does not apply, under section 60ZS of that Act.

Once a PNF Plan is approved by Local Land Services, all forestry operations must be carried out in accordance with the applicable Private Native Forestry Code of Practice (PNF Code), as current at the time of operation. Prior to carrying out forestry operations under this PNF Plan, advice should be sought from Local Land Services to identify the applicable PNF Code.

Any person who carries out forestry operations under this PNF Plan must comply with the requirements of the applicable PNF Code. This applies to both landholders and any other persons who carry out forestry operations. Forestry operations must not commence until this plan is approved by Local Land Services under Part 5B of the *Local Land Services Act 2013*, and a Forest Management Plan (FMP) has been approved by Local Land Services, other than when undertaking small scale harvesting operations, in accordance with the applicable PNF Code.

This PNF Plan is to be in effect for the period specified in the approved Plan.

#### SCHEDULE ONE - MAPPING

I/We agree to the provision of a suitable map by Local Land Services which will identify areas where this PNF Plan may be applied on the land described by this PNF Plan. I/We note that areas unsuitable for private native forestry will be excluded from the PNF Plan. The map provided by Local Land Services will form part of this PNF Plan. The land subject to this PNF Plan will be indicated on a map, described in Schedule One to the approved PNF Plan, as the “PNF area”. The map will include those landscape features and drainage features for which digital information is held by Local Land Services at the time of this Plan being made.

#### SCHEDULE TWO - STANDARD CONDITIONS

##### Forestry operations

1. This PNF Plan is requested for the purposes of undertaking the following forestry operations (as defined in the *Local Land Services Act 2013*) to be carried out in a sustainable manner on the PNF area;
  - a. logging operations—namely the cutting and removal of timber from land for the purpose of timber production, or

- b. the harvesting of forest products—namely the harvesting of the products of trees and other vegetation (other than timber) that are of economic value, or
- c. ongoing forest management operations—namely activities relating to the management of land for timber production such as thinning, burning and other silvicultural activities, or
- d. ancillary activities to enable or assist in the above operations such as the provision of roads, snig tracks, waterway crossings and temporary timber storage facilities.

#### **Other approvals**

- 2. I/We will obtain all other approvals which may be required from other government agencies which may be otherwise necessary to carry out the activities proposed by this PNF Plan.

#### **Notification of commencement and completion of forestry operations**

- 3. The Landholder must notify Local Land Services of the commencement and completion of forestry operations:
  - a. Within 30 days prior to commencement, and
  - b. Within 30 days of the completion of the forestry operations under this PNF Plan.

#### **Notes**

- 4. I/We wish to have my/our Personal information contained in this PNF plan treated in accordance with the *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998*, under which I/We have rights of access and correction.
- 5. I/We agree to certain information contained in this PNF plan being provided in the following fashion:
  - (a) landholder name, postal address and contact number may be used for compliance purposes.
  - (b) area (hectares) and district locality names may be used for compliance and statistical purposes.
  - (c) details of this plan may be fully disclosed to the applicable local council and used for compliance and statistical purposes.
  - (d) details of this plan may be disclosed in circumstances where disclosure is otherwise required or authorised by law, including the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009*.
  - (e) all details of this plan may be fully disclosed to the person listed as the applicant in item 1 (*Details of applicant submitting this Draft PNF Plan*) on page 1 of this plan.
- 6. Authorised officers of the Environment Protection Authority may monitor compliance with this Plan. All activities authorised by this Plan will be carried out in accordance with this Plan and in accordance with the relevant private native forestry code of practice.
